As part of a new and exciting community initiative, Strathfield Council is launching a commuter bus called the Strathfield Connector!

The bus will service residents of Strathfield LGA connecting them with local shops, restaurants and businesses.

Running 7 days a week, every 30 minutes from 7am - 7pm, the main stops include:


- Strathfield Square

PROJECTS



HUDSON PARK GOLF COURSE CLOSURE & STRATHFIELD DISTRICT PARK

The Hudson Park Golf Course is now permanently closed and work has commenced on an Urban District Park. The Strathfield District Park will include a new driving range, sports courts, a playground, picnic areas, scenic lake, substantial tree planting and a café.



HOMEBUSH WEST TOWN CENTRE UPGRADE

Strathfield Council is working to improve the appearance of Henley Road. The project has commenced with the section of Henley Road between The Crescent and Exeter Road becoming one way. Included in the upgrade is the implementation of 45 degree parking on the eastern side, new paving, planter beds, trees, bins and benches. Civil construction has commenced and will be carried out over the next 4 months.



SYNTHETIC FIELDS UNDERWAY

The ground is currently being prepared for two new synthetic fields at Strathfield Park and Cooke Park. The fields are expected to be completed by mid-year and will no doubt bring hours of enjoyment to our local sports stars!
