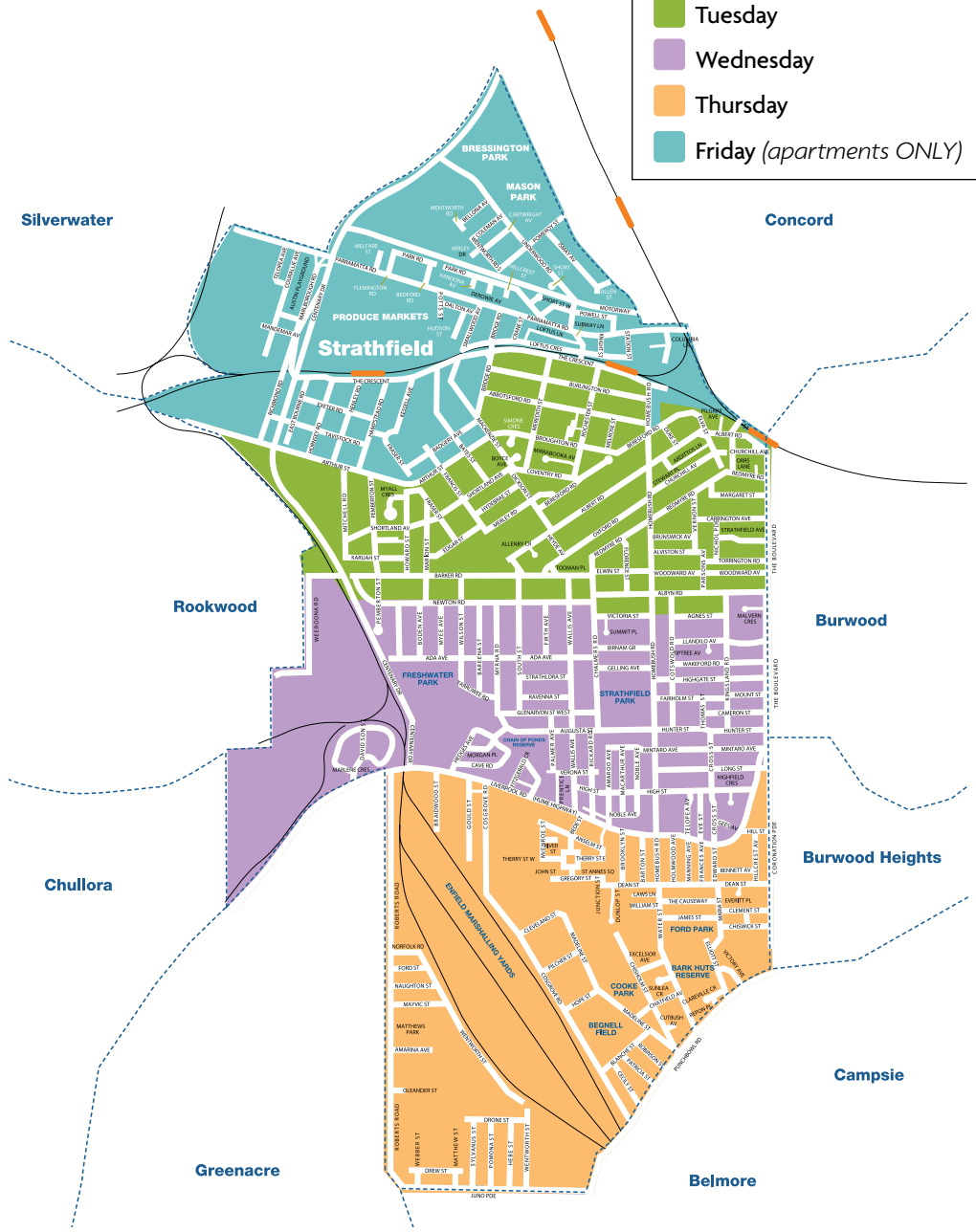

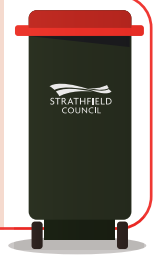

To ensure collection, place all waste in the bin with the lid fully closed.



Overfilled bins attract vermin and animals and can lead to litter.



**Don't overfill** or pack bins too tightly.



Place bins **away from other objects** with the **front facing the street**.



Place bins out the **night before collection day**.



Bring bins in **within 12 hours** after collection.

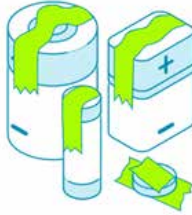

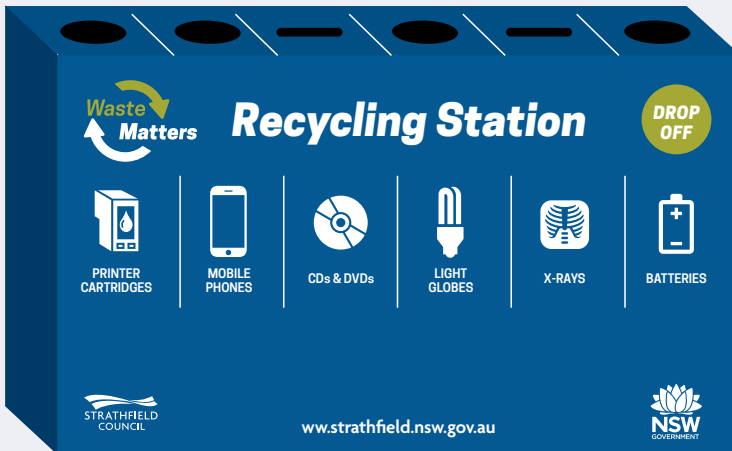

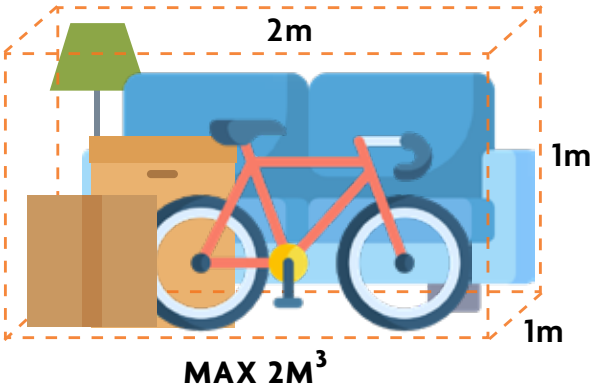

## COUNCIL RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REFUSE COLLECTION.

- If you live in a unit/apartment, contact your building manager to organise a communal collection.
- Up to 3 booked clean up collections per year.
- Loose items need to be contained or tied up.
- Council hosts annual drop-off waste events for various household items. Visit our website for more information.

Before booking a clean up collection, you should try rehoming your pre-loved goods to friends and family, a local charity, or try selling them online to reduce the amount sent to landfill.

# COUNCIL'S SUSTAINABLE INITIATIVES



**RESPONSIBLE CAFES**

Responsible Cafes is a not-for-profit focusing on addressing material waste in Australia. They invite cafes and customers to bring their own (BYO) reusable items—such as coffee cups, containers, straws, bags, and cutlery—every Friday, helping to reduce waste.

Strathfield Council is among 80 councils partnering with Responsible Cafes to utilize their tools and platform to engage local cafes, promote sustainable businesses, and shift the conversation around single-use plastics in our community. This initiative aims to keep our environment clean and healthy. Since the program's launch, the Council has connected with numerous café owners, providing signage for participating businesses and facilitating ongoing discussions to assess the program's impact.

*RECYCLING FOOD WASTE INTO COMPOST*

**Strathfield's Food Organics Garden Organics (FOGO) service will be coming soon. Once FOGO starts, you will be able to place food waste into your existing green garden waste bin to be recycled into compost.**

### **WHY FOGO?**

- ❧ The NSW Government has mandated all councils to go FOGO by 2030. We will soon be undertaking community consultations and audits to gradually transition to the FOGO service.
- ❧ Food waste makes up to 45% of our red lid garbage bin waste. By diverting this waste from landfill into creating compost, we can reduce the amount of harmful greenhouse gas emissions created.
- ❧ Compost made from the food waste collected will be used in gardens and farms across NSW.

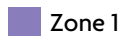

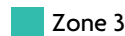

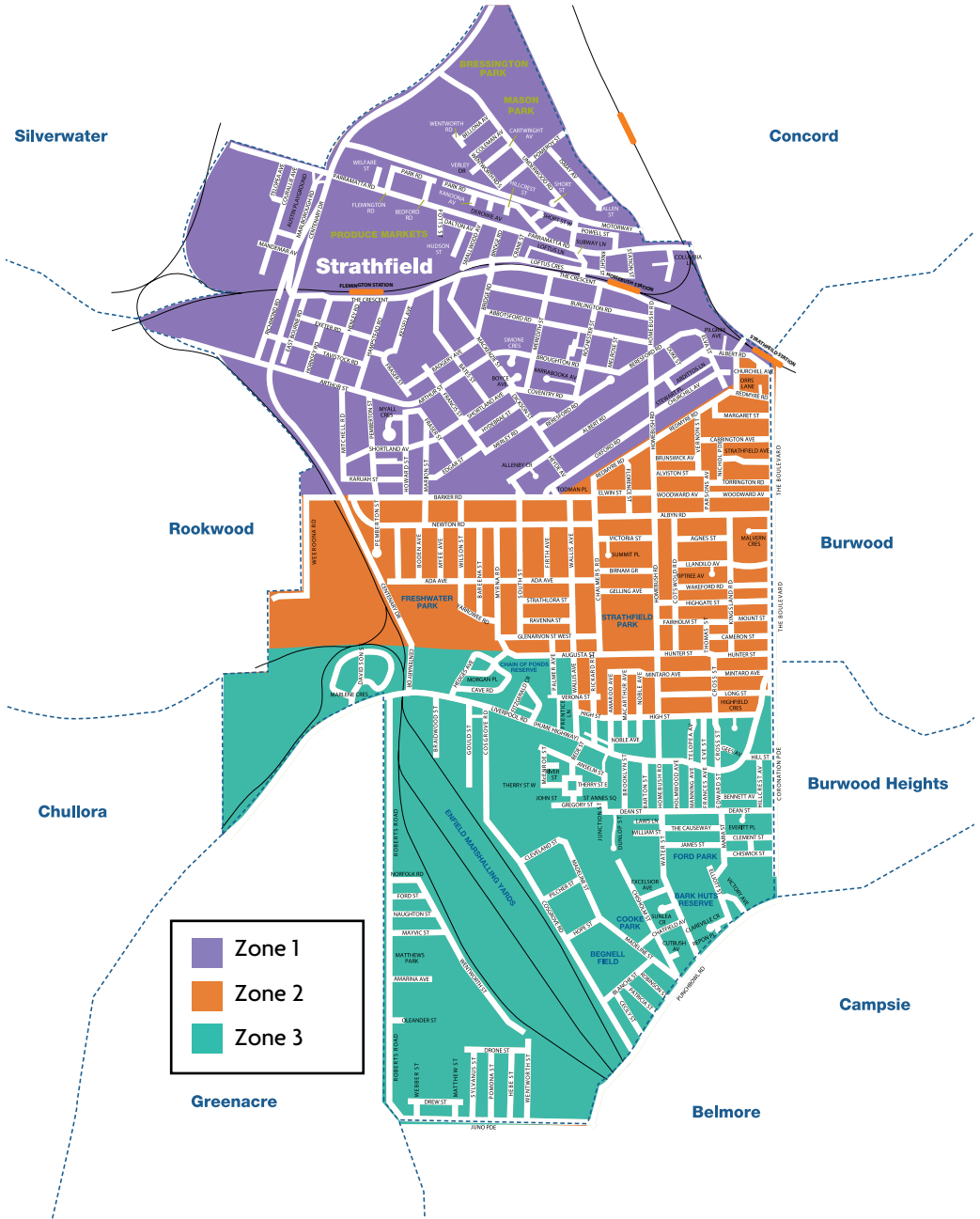
