Summary of exhibition

'Somewhere in Between' is an exhibition which explores the vacillation between good and bad. Using cyanotype printmaking as the primary media, and entomology as the major subject matter, the exhibition will invite the viewer to reflect on bugs (and what qualities of insects evoke reverence or conversely repulsion) and the place of bugs in our life.

Insects are by far the most varied and abundant animals, outweighing humanity by 17 times, and are essential to the ecosystems humanity depends upon. They pollinate plants, are food for other creatures and recycle nature's waste. Yet we spend our time shooing and squatting the bugs away.

Recent studies have led scientists to warn of "catastrophic consequences for the survival of mankind" if insect losses were not halted. Insects are the blueprint of the environment, so it seems apt to celebrate the humble bug using cyanotype printing along with other multi-modal forms such as embroidery and painting. References to historical recording of entomology, and play with scale of the insects is also explored.
